**DIRECTIONS**

READ AND UNDERSTAND LABEL AND MATERIAL SAFETY DATA SHEET BEFORE USE.

1. Presort laundry to wash.
2. Presoak or pre-spot laundry when necessary.
3. Place proper amount of laundry into laundry machine.
4. For wash cycle, use recommended laundry detergent at the proper dilution.
5. When bleaching, use 2-3 ounces of POWDERED BLEACH per 100 lbs. of dry cloth.
6. When souring and/or softening, use recommended sour and/or softener at the proper use dilution.

**WARNING**
